***Below is a list of the defining characteristics of the Building Tomorrow's Church conference; in other words, those attributes which makes BTC, BTC:***

-  An annual assembly of professing believers in the United States
-  Target audience of young adults from Reformed Baptist churches, ages 18 to 30-something
-  Under the authority and oversight of a board of elders of a Reformed Baptist church or churches
-  Directed or coordinated by at least one member of an ARBCA church who has had positive, ongoing relationships with other Reformed Baptist churches; someone who is linked to the wider Reformed Baptist network in America
-  Planned, organized, and carried out by a committee comprised of members of a Reformed Baptist church or churches
-  Only speakers who are Reformed Baptist pastors, elders, or missionaries, with at least one of whom is currently serving at an ARBCA church
-  Conference themes and message topics that directly or indirectly relate to the doctrine of the Church and the people of the local church
-  Held at a facility that offers on-site lodging and nearby activities for conference attendees
-  All (or mostly)-inclusive conference registration price that would cover the cost of each attendee's food & lodging (at least)
-  Songs that are both theologically accurate and aesthetically pleasing
-  Due consideration of other Reformed Baptist church styles and practices when deciding conference songs choices and music
-  Songs led and accompanied by qualified musicians with experience in leading a congregation in song
-  Appropriate time given at each conference for relationship building between conference attendees; organized activities to reflect this objective
