



**I**n April of 2007, after a round-table discussion about the possibility of a nation-wide conference for young Reformed Baptists, then-missionary Don Donell expressed the following thoughts in an email to the conference organizer:

## '10 Theme

### ***"The Church and Missions"***

The Building Tomorrow's Church ministry seeks to communicate that same evangelistic sentiment that C.H. Spurgeon expressed in his 1856 sermon on Gospel Missions:

*"We feel persuaded that all of you are of one mind in this matter, that it is the absolute duty as well as the eminent privilege of the Church to proclaim the gospel to the world. We do not conceive that God will do his own work without instruments, but that, as he has always employed means in the work of the regeneration of this world, he will still continue to do the same, and that it becomes the Church to do its utmost to spread the truth wherever it can reach the ear of man."*

Thus, the activity of missions is an important part of the ministry of the local church, and therefore deserves our attention as individual Christians and faithful church members.

This year's theme, "The Church and Missions," deals specifically with the wonderful responsibility that Christ left with His disciples to take God's Word to the ends of the world. At this summer's conference, Pastors Donell and Perron will address the parts that all of the church's members should play in reaching the lost with the gospel.

It is our great desire to see the lives of young people sanctified by the power of the Gospel through the Holy Spirit's conviction and encouragement in hearts that love the Lord and His people. We "expect great things from God" as we "attempt great things for God" through this annual conference. We have yet to find out how many future missionaries, church planters, elders, deacons, or Sunday school teachers may be raised up through one of these conferences, but we look forward to what the Lord might do. *"Let the favor of the Lord our God be upon us, and establish the work of our hands upon us; yes, establish the work of our hands!"* (Psalm 90:17). ### Transportation

Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport to Conference (Prescott Pines Camp, Prescott).....  
Then from campgrounds back to Phoenix airport—

### Shuttle “U” Prescott

- Arrangements should be made by the traveling party(s) through **SHUTTLE “U” PRESCOTT** at least **2 weeks prior** to the conference.
- Shuttle “U” has a large fleet of vans that will conduct hourly pickups from any of the three Phoenix Sky Harbor Terminals.
- Travelers will be delivered directly to the Prescott Pines campground on Friday.
- Travelers leaving the campgrounds on Monday should plan on being picked up at least **4 hours** prior to their flight time.
- Shuttle “U” will transport the traveler from the campground to their departing terminal at Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport.

## Guidelines & Dress Code

Because BTC is a conference for Christian adults, it is expected that all attendees will behave in a mature, Christ-like manner. We do not intend to police the conference attendees or act as parents. Our hope is that as Christian brothers and sisters, attendees will hold one another accountable to the standards of living provided in the Word of God.

However, with that said, there will be conference staff and pastoral leadership on hand to assist in reminding attendees of Scriptural standards and to enforce the campground's rules as necessary.

To assist you in advance, here are some basic guidelines to consider when preparing for and attending the conference:

- Show love and deference for one another.
- Refrain from argumentation or public confrontation.
- Respect one another's personal belongings.
- Honor the Sabbath by keeping it holy.
- Dress modestly.
  - Ladies—No tight-fitting or see-through clothing; no low-cut tops; and no questionable or offensive slogans or designs on clothing.
  - Men—No tight or baggy pants/shorts; shirts should be worn unless swimming; and no questionable or offensive slogans or designs on clothing.

### Other Camp Rules:

- No alcoholic beverages or non-prescription/non-medical drugs.
- No firearms, explosives, or fireworks.
- No smoking in any of the buildings.
- Amplified music is not permitted outdoors.
- No pets permitted on the campground.

## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q: How many people will be coming to BTC?**

**A:** We expect to have at least 100 attendees made up of single and married young adults.

**Q: What will the weather be like in May?**

**A:** It will probably be warm during the day (in the ° 80s-90s F...dry, not humid!), but it should cool down in the evenings enough to wear a light jacket or sweater.

**Q: What can I expect each session to include?**

**A:** Each session will include announcements, the singing of hymns, psalms, and spiritual songs, and a message from Pastors Perron and Donell on the theme of "The Church and Missions." Sunday morning's session will be treated as corporate Sabbath worship.

**Q: What are "Breakout Sessions"?**

**A:**

- 30-40 minutes following 3 different sessions with Pastors Donell and Perron
- Groups of 10 or less led by Pastors and/or other leaders
- Includes group discussion about prior message and a time of prayer
- Each leader will have planned discussion questions given to him by the speakers
- The goal is to discover and discuss the practical implications of each session
- The leader will play the part of discussion moderator, not a lecturer
- Close with specific topic for prayer
- Breakout groups will change throughout the weekend

**Q: What food is provided?**

**A:**

- 8 full meals (Friday night through Monday morning)
- Professional Chef on-site
- Snack bar on-site
- Vending machines on-site

**Q: Will my cell phone have service at the campground?**

**A:** Most cell phones should get reception at this location. To be sure, however, check with your cell phone service provider.

**Q: What if I don't have the money to attend?**

**A:** It is highly recommended that individuals plan fundraising events within their local churches to help offset the cost of each individual's registration and transportation to BTC. Examples of fundraisers would be car washes, church rummage sales, chili cook-offs, etc.

**Q: How much money should I plan on bringing to the conference?**

**A:** Plan on having enough cash for snack bar purchases, for any book purchases at the book table, and to cover meals before or after the conference.

**Q: How do I get to Prescott Pines?**

**A:** It is recommended that individuals try to “team up” with others in their vicinity to drive to the conference. If you plan on flying, you will need to make your own flight arrangements to Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport and arrange transportation from Phoenix to the conference (approximately 2 hours north of Phoenix).

**Q: What time is check-in and check-out?**

**A: Check-in** time is 4:00pm on Friday afternoon. Please do not come to the camp earlier than 1pm. If you arrive in Prescott early, there are plenty of shops and restaurants in Downtown Prescott to hang out. After 4pm, be sure to check in at the Welcome Table near the Office.

**Check-out** will be after the closing session on Monday morning. Please be sure to have your things packed and your sleeping area picked up by noon.

**Q: What if I have special needs/requests (food, disabilities, lodging, etc.)?**

**A:** Please fill out the “special requests” field on the enclosed Registration Form and mail that to Grace Covenant Church or email us. We will do our best to meet your needs.

**Q: What about staying longer and going on extra excursions?**
